### Eligibility Requirements

1. U.S. resident for one year at time of application
2. Current U.S. High School senior
3. GPA of 2.5 to 3.5 (4.0 scale)
4. Applicants must be accepted for admission to a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited U.S. two- or four-year college or university

### Application Instructions

Complete the attached application. Please staple all application documents together and place in a single mailing envelope to the address listed below between March 3, 2008 and March 17, 2008. **Applications received outside of this time period will be discarded.** Applications must be complete and submitted as directed to ensure consideration. Applications that include additional documents not requested by the Harrington Foundation *will not be considered*. Selected recipients will be notified by U.S. mail in May 2008.

**Recipients of a Harrington Foundation Scholarship will need to complete a W-9 and return to the Harrington Foundation before any scholarship money is awarded to the recipient.**

### Scholarship Selection Criteria

Candidates for a Harrington Foundation Scholarship will be selected based on a combination of:

1. Academic Achievement
2. Student Essay (see page 3)
3. Postsecondary Letter of Acceptance
4. One-Page Resumé

### **Postsecondary Institution Letter of Acceptance**

Please include a copy of your acceptance letter from an accredited postsecondary institution.

### **Resumé**

Complete and attach a one-page resumé. The succinct resumé should provide an overall description of achievements, academics, extracurricular activities, and work experience. **Applications with resumé that exceed one page will not be considered.**

*\*Applications missing information or materials or received outside of the specified time period will be discarded.  
Applications that include additional documents not requested such as CDs, photos, and transcripts will be discarded.*
