Purpose of the Scholarship

The Jack & Jane Meyers Family Scholarship will provide financial support to graduates from Cunningham High School to continue his/her education in a college, university, or vocational school (trade school or career school).

About the Jack & Jane Meyers Family Scholarship

Jack and Jane Meyers and their descendants have had their lives greatly enriched and blessed by having lived and grown among the people of Cunningham and its surrounding area. As such, in honor of the selfless community service demonstrated by the people of Cunningham which has defined its proud past and will determine its future, they wish to support a worthy student from this area in pursuit of his/her academic goals.

Scholarship Guiding Principles:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior or past graduate of Cunningham High school (for renewal applications) and must be pursuing higher education at a college, university, or vocational school.
- 2. Applicant should have a 3.0 cumulative grade point average or better at Cunningham High School and/or the institution where currently enrolled (as applicable for renewal applications).
- 3. Applicant should be well rounded with involvement in multiple extracurricular school activities and one or more community activities, preferably reflecting a spirit of volunteerism, the focus of this scholarship
- 4. Applicant should have consistently demonstrated a high degree of respect for the people of Cunningham and School faculty throughout their time as a student in the school district.

The above guiding principles outline the expectations of the recipient(s), but, other than #1 above, the rest will not be the sole basis for selecting recipients. Failure to meet any one of the above criteria (excluding #1 which is required), will not disqualify an individual from consideration. If the applicant feels he/she reasonably meets the above principles, he/she is encouraged to complete the application process according to the Scholarship Application Guide that begins on the following page.

8. General information on the Scholarship:

- This Scholarship will be administered by the West Kingman County Education Foundation.
- Recipients will be determined by a three person committee made up of one current faculty member of Cunningham High School, one member of the Cunningham City Council, and one member or direct descendent of the Jack and Jane Meyers Family as appointed by Jack & Jane Meyers. In the event there is no Jack Meyers Family descendent willing and able to serve in this duty, the Family can designate this position to someone in the community or surrounding area. Primary consideration shall be given to the applicant of most merit rather than need, actual or perceived.
- The total scholarship amount in any given year shall be \$1,000, which may be awarded either to one recipient, or split among two recipients, as determined by the Committee. If awarded to two graduating seniors, the amount will be split evenly.

In the event at least one recipient is a past graduate, the committee shall have the right to split the \$1,000 as they deem appropriate.

By signing and submitting this application, the applicant is authorizing any school they have attended or are presently attending to verify any information they have supplied on this application form.
