The essay must be no more than 300 words, typewritten, double spaced and attached to the application form provided by the Association. The Association will choose five (5) winners based upon writing skills, content, academic achievements and potential for making a contribution to society. Each winner will receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship.

The Association will select winners by April 21, 2023. Winners will be announced at the awards banquet or graduation program of the winners’ schools. The Association will pay scholarships to the registrar of the accredited college or vocational school upon receiving proof of enrollment for the fall 2023 term.
